| <b>6. Description of content:</b> Approves the regulations on wood packaging material in international trade.<br><p style="text-align: center;">Chapter I<br/>General Provisions</p> <p>Article 1. Objectives</p> <p>1.1. Establish procedures and regulations permitting the efficient inspection of wood packaging material in international trade and the registration, control and monitoring of companies authorized to carry out the phytosanitary treatment of wood packaging under International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPM) 15.</p> <p>1.2. Reduce the risk of the introduction and/or spread of quarantine pests associated with wood packaging material used in the transport of commodities in international trade.</p> <p>1.3. Specify the phytosanitary procedures for authorizing the function and application of the phytosanitary treatment of wood packaging material.</p> <p>Article 2. Scope</p> <p>These regulations shall be applicable throughout the national territory and binding, without exception, on natural and legal persons and public and private entities engaged in international trade in and transport of goods.</p> |

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| <p>Article 3. Wood packaging material covered by the regulations</p> <p>The types of wood packaging subject to the application of these regulations are pallets, dunnage panels, crating, packaging blocks, drums, cases, load boards, pallet collars and skids, of a thickness exceeding six millimetres, and packaging which can be present in any imported or exported commodities, including imports and/or exports not normally subject to phytosanitary inspection.</p> <p>Article 4. Wood packaging material not covered by the regulations</p> <p>The types of wood packaging excluded from the application of these regulations are those made wholly of wood-based products such as plywood, particle board, oriented strand board or veneer that have been created using glue, heat and pressure or a combination thereof, and wood packaging material such as veneer peeler cores, sawdust, wood wool, wood shavings and raw wood cut to a thickness not exceeding six millimetres.</p> |
