These requirements include the need for a Plant Import Permit (PIP), phytosanitary certificate, physical inspections and adherence to wood packaging standards for containerized cargo according to the *International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures No. 15: Guidelines for Regulating Wood Packing Material in International Trade (ISPM 15).*

In addition, Kenya has provided a list of approved entities for the treatment of wood packaging material in line with the ISPM 15 measures.
