**Regulation Amending the Regulation on Marking the Wooden Packaging Material for Phytosanitary Measures**

**ARTICLE 1-** Article 26 annexed with the Regulation published in the Official Journal dated 4<sup>th</sup> June 2004 and numbered 25482 to the Regulation on Marking the Wooden Packaging Material for Phytosanitary Measures published in Official Journal dated 4<sup>th</sup> May 2004 and numbered 25452 was amended as follows:

“**Article 26-** ISPM 15 conditions will be obligatory for the products imported to our country in wooden packaging material as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2006.”

**ARTICLE 2** — This Regulation comes into force on the date of its publication.
