The following communication, dated 8 October 2004, is being circulated at the request of the Delegation of the <u>European Communities</u>.

Wood and wood packaging material circulating under Chapter 44 (Headings CN 4401, 4402, 4403, 4404, 4406, 4407, 4415, 4416) and Heading 9406; ICS:55

The Proposal notified in G/SPS/N/EEC/221 (10 November 2003) has been adopted as "Commission Directive 2004/102/EC of 5 October 2004 amending Annexes II, III, IV and V to Council Directive 2000/29/EC on protective measures against the introduction into the Community of organisms harmful to plants or plant products and against their spread within the Community (Official Journal L 309, 6 October 2004, pages 9-25).

The enforcement of these measures will be 1 March 2005.

The directive takes into account Article 10 (Special and Differential Treatment) of the SPS Agreement by allowing <u>more flexibility</u> on other dates of application of the logo (as part of the mark) and on the conditions required for the manufacturing of dunnage:

Logo (as part of the mark)

For Wood packaging material manufactured, repaired or recycled before 28 February 2005, the logo specified in Annex II to the ISPM15 is <u>not applicable</u> until <u>31 December 2007</u>.

Dunnage

Dunnage can be made from bark-free wood that is free from pests and signs of live pests until <u>31</u> <u>December 2007.</u>
