6. Description of content: The purpose of this Resolution is to establish procedures for the certification of wood packaging manufactured from unworked wood for export and produced in plants authorized by the Autonomous Agricultural Health Service (SASA), and to regulate wood packaging manufactured from unworked wood accompanying imports.

It applies only to packaging used for any plant, plant product, storage place, packaging, conveyance, container, soil and any other organism, object or material capable of harbouring or spreading pests, deemed to require phytosanitary measures, particularly in international transportation.

Treatment: Officially authorized procedure for killing, eliminating or sterilizing pests.

6. Description of content: (cont'd)

Heat treatment: Process whereby a basic product is heated to a minimum temperature for a minimum period, in accordance with officially recognized technical specifications.

Furthermore, any natural or legal person interested in the production, marketing and phytosanitary treatment of wood packaging must register with the Autonomous Agricultural Health Service (SASA).
